CONFERENCE ON "MIGRATION WITHIN A BRITISH CARIBBEAN FEDERATION" IN TRINIDAD, B.W.I.

A conference on Migration within a British Caribbean Federation commenced in Port of Spain, Trinidad, on March 14, and will continue until March 18, under the Chairmanship of the Rt. Hon. Lord Lloyd, Parliamentary Under Secretary of State for the Colonies. The Conference is being attended by delegates from all the Colonies in the British Caribbean with the exception of British Honduras and British Guiana, the latter sending an Observer.

British Honduras and British Guiana are not yet agreed on whether they should enter the Federation of the British Caribbean.

His Excellency the Governor, Sir Hubert Rance, G.C.M.G., G.B.E., C. B., formally opens the migration talks in a welcome speech at the Legislative Council Chamber. At left of the Governor is Sir Stephen Luke, Comptroller for Development and Welfare in the West Indies, while at his right is Lord Lloyd, M.B.E., Parliamentary Under Secretary of State for the Colonies, and Mr. Norman Manley, Q.C., Chief Minister of Jamaica. At extreme right of the table can be seen the Honourable Albert Gomes, Minister of Labour, Industry and Commerce, and immediately behind him is the Honourable L.C. Hannays, Minister without portfolio, Trinidad's two delegates to the Conference.
